BOB ROSS STYLE PAINTING Friday, September 8, 3-6 p.m. Please note that this is NOT a sanctioned Bob Ross class, but John Chiego will guide the group through the Bob Ross style to produce beautiful paintings. \$50.00 includes all supplies. The style uses a wet-on-wet technique with three colors, three brushes, and a palette knife; fun and easy to learn!

ACRYLIC POURING AND MIXING COLORS Saturday, September 9, 6-8 p.m. Acrylic pouring is a form of liquid art that involves mixing different colors with a pouring medium and then pouring the paint directly onto the canvas without using a brush, gently moving the paint around by tilting the canvas. Jacqueline LaCasse will help you create a beautiful poured painting, and she says you should wear old clothes and put your hair up! \$30.00, supplies included.

STUFFIES! Friday, September 15. Learn basic sewing techniques to design and create unique stuffed creatures. Two classes for different age groups, taught by Phyllis Stapp: Ages 7-12 will come from 10 a.m.-12 noon, and ages 12-19 will come from 1-3 p.m. All supplies are provided for the \$15.00 fee.

SKULLS IN PLASTER OF PARIS is a two-day class with Phyllis Stapp on September 22 and October 6. The first session will have the students mixing and pouring plaster of Paris into molds, and then they can paint a pastel pumpkin or jack-o-lantern. For the second class, the plaster skulls will be dry and ready for decorating and painting, and then the students can finish the paintings they began in the first session, or create an ink drawing. Ages 8-12 from 10 a.m.-12 noon, ages 12-19 from 12 noon-3 p.m. \$30.00 for both classes, supplies provided.
